- Artists will proceed to Effie Yeaw Nature Center located inside Ancil Hoffman County Park, 2850 San Lorenzo Way, off Tarshes Drive in Carmichael, CA 95608, and will check in between 9-10am, May 15th in the parking lot of the Nature Center with blank paper, and or canvas. There is a \$5 fee to enter the park.
- At the Plein Air table artists will be issued name tags and info packet, including map.
- Artists who ARE participating in the Show and Sell will pay to ARNHA \$30 which includes a Gala ticket.
- Artists who do NOT wish to show and sell at the Gala pay no fee and will join us in the event. Donations appreciated.
- Artists may then go out into the Ancil Hoffman Park which includes the Effie Yeaw Nature Center and paint.
- Painting is limited to Hoffman Park. Painting ends at 1-1:30pm and artists return work to the Plein Air table to prepare it for sale and display. Artists will asked to loan an easel for display. A limited amount of table top easels will be available. All art should be displayed by 3:30pm. Volunteers will assist.
- These art works should be priced to sell, 50% commission to ARNHA.
- We are planning a potluck social hour for the artists at the Plein Air table between 1:30-2:30pm. Bring some snacks to share!
- Artwork not sold at the Gala can be picked up after the Gala or the following week during regular Nature Center Hours.
- The 3rd Saturday Paint Out Group and Sacramento Plein Air Painter Meetup.com group are sponsors and are providing volunteers.
- ALL proceeds go to ARNHA for Effie Yeaw Nature Center.
